- **98.9 million ha** of organic farmland worldwide in 2023 a **2.6% increase** from 2022.
- 4.33 million organic producers active globally.

 - o Latin America & Caribbean: 10.3 million ha
 - Asia: 9.1 million haAfrica: 3.4 million ha
 - o North America: 3.3 million ha
- Global organic market value in 2023: 136.4 billion €.

While the world embraces organic farming, **Zimbabwe is still lagging behind**. However, progress is evident: organically certified producers have grown from **7,883**

in 2021 to 25,339 in 2025, reflecting the determination of rural smallholder farmers to meet international demand while protecting biodiversity and soil health.

This momentum offers a unique opportunity for Zimbabwe to expand organic production, create sustainable jobs, and access premium global markets – but it requires stronger policy support, investment, and collaboration across the agricultural sector.

On Friday, 12 September 2025, the Organic Farming Academy will host this year's Organic Day Zimbabwe.

The event will bring together farmers, youth, policymakers, development partners, and private sector leaders to:
